The basic membership dues for 2011-12 will be \$140 / couple (\$70 / person) if received by September 1. The cost increases to \$146 / couple (\$73 / person) after this date. Invited guests are admitted free for their first dance of the year. Single dances are \$25 / couple (\$13 / person).

A stamped envelope is enclosed with this mailing to encourage members to return the form and payment in a timely manner.

The initial dance for the 2011-2012 season will be September 30, 2011 at the Elks Club in Boalsburg. As in the past, the club offers seven dances between September and May for all of its members (and their guests). There will be six different dance bands this season to provide music for our dancing and listening pleasure. For an optional dining enjoyment prior to dancing, there will be three dinner dances. Information about the first dinner dance and cost are enclosed with the second attachment in this mailing. According to diners' comments from last year, the food preparation from Zola's has been excellent. Those of you not choosing the dinner options in the past might wish to reconsider for this season. The cost for the dinner is in addition to the membership cost.
